##### **Background:**

KSCST has been allotted the project to monitor and evaluate the watershed project works comes under Belgaum revenue division for undertaking Monitoring, Evaluation, Learning and Documentation IWMP programme implemented by Department of Watershed development, Government of Karnataka for the period of 5 years from 2011 to 2016. The Belgaum division comprising 7 districts has 69 projects covering treatable area of 2, 87,000ha.

##### **Objectives:**

- To undertake baseline survey to collect and create database on Socio-economy, infrastructure, Bio-physical and Natural resources of the watershed areas
- To conduct the concurrent process monitoring of the works executed by WDD under Integrated Watershed Development Programme (IWMP)
- To Evaluate and Carry out the Impact Assessment of productivity, socio-economic and environmental or Bio-Physical indicators using advanced scientific and Geospatial technologies.

##### **Progress:**

- Prepared and submitted the final impact evaluation report on Bio-physical and Socio-economical activities to the Watershed Development Department, GOK during January 2017
- Preparation of Satellite based Impact Assessment Report has been completed containing change detection of land use/land cover pattern of water shed area due to interventions of watershed activities and submitted to WDD, GOK
- Presented the Final Impact Assessment report for Batch 1 and Batch 2 projects during June 2017 before the officers of Watershed Development Department of Government of Karnataka.
